

The "Big 7" Proposals Plan: A Vision for District 64

The Mission: To restore affordability, empower our diverse families, and ensure that Tallahassee works for the people of Tampa Bay, not the special interests.

1. Strengthening Community and Family Support

Goal: *Build a Florida where families thrive and feel secure.*

- The "Prosperity Hub" Initiative: Establish community-based hubs that provide one-stop access to health services, job placement, and educational resources.
- Neighborhood Voice Program: Implement quarterly "Town Hall Forums" across District 64 to ensure local needs directly inform state legislation.
- Immigrant & Cultural Integration: Champion funding for cultural programs that celebrate the heritage and diverse demographic groups of Tampa Bay, fostering a more inclusive and unified district.

2. Improving Local Education

Goal: *Equip our schools with the tools to prepare every student for the future.*

- The "Teacher First" Raise: Fight for a permanent state-funded salary increase for District 64 educators to stop the teacher shortage and improve classroom quality.
- Infrastructure Modernization: Secure state grants to repair aging school buildings and expand high-speed internet access in every classroom.
- Closing the Opportunity Gap: Increase funding for Title I schools to provide low-income students with tutoring, technology, and career-readiness programs.

3. Employment and Economic Opportunities

Goal: *Boost local growth by supporting small businesses and the workforce.*

- Small Business Growth Credits: Create tax incentives for District 64 small businesses that hire locally and provide livable wages.
- Tampa Bay Workforce Pipeline: Partner with local community colleges to align vocational training programs with the high-demand sectors of the Tampa Bay economy, such as healthcare, tech, and trades.

4. Infrastructure and Environment

Goal: *Protect our natural resources while lowering the cost of living.*

- Solar for Energy Independence: Support "Solar-for-Savings" programs that use solar energy to offset the high demand from AI and data centers, keeping residential electric bills low.
- Resilient Water Systems: Prioritize funding to modernize drinking water and stormwater infrastructure to prevent flooding and ensure clean, safe water for all families.
- Sustainable Urban Growth: Advocate for infrastructure projects that balance development with the preservation of Florida's unique wetlands and green spaces.

5. Community Participation and Representation

Goal: *Ensure every resident is heard and every dollar is tracked.*

- State-Level Transparency: Mandate clearer reporting on how state tax dollars are spent within District 64.
- Open Access Governance: Hold regular "Representation Sessions" to provide constituents with direct, easy access to their state representative without the need for an appointment or a lobbyist.

6. Car Insurance Premium Reduction

Goal: *Aggressively tackle the rising cost of driving.*

- Safe Streets Awareness: Launch a district-wide initiative to reward safe driving habits and reduce local accident rates.
- AI Fraud Prevention: Introduce legislation to use AI-driven fraud detection to eliminate "staged accident" scams that drive up premiums.

- The "Negotiation Table": Use data-driven safety improvements to negotiate lower, permanent insurance premium rates for District 64 residents with state regulators and insurance companies.

7. Home Insurance and Tax Relief for Seniors

Goal: *Protect our seniors from being priced out of their own homes.*

- The Senior Security Freeze: Propose a legislative "Senior Freeze" that locks in property tax rates and home insurance premiums for residents aged 65+ on a fixed income.
- Protection for Solo Seniors: Specifically target relief for seniors living alone, ensuring that the rising cost of living does not result in the loss of their homes.
